#### DEADLINE: FRIDAY, SEPTEMBER 6, 2024

#### **RULES & REGULATIONS:**

- This exhibit is open only to artists with developmental disabilities
- All artistic mediums are accepted (except for coloring book pages or crayons)
- No more than 4 pieces per artist may be submitted.
- Submissions cannot be larger than 36" X 36" or weigh more than 10 lbs.
- Three dimensional art must be free standing
- Art must be acceptable for family viewing
- Photographic artwork must be printed and delivered (No digital submissions)
- Art MUST be submitted with a completed and signed artist packet
- A jury will select which pieces will be included in the exhibit & all selections are final
- All selected art will be in the silent auction. No art is selected for exhibit only
- Only artists whose art is selected will receive free admission to the event

Please note: Since we are no longer partnering with a framing company, we encourage all artwork to come framed. We cannot guarantee that we will be able to frame your artwork.

## **ARTIST CONTRACT**

### If the selection committee selects your artwork, the following Rules & Regulations apply. Please read before signing.

- The Arc Baltimore ("The Arc") will notify selected artists by email or mail by 9/18/24.
- The artist agrees that The Arc can display their selected artwork virtually, at Art in the Round ("the event") on 10/25/24, and on the mobile bidding app.
- The Arc will exhibit and auction off the artist's selected artwork at the event. The artist will receive 60% of the auction price, and the artist agrees that The Arc may use a reproduction of their art as gifts and for promotional purposes, and shall not be entitled to any compensation for such uses.
- In order to process the artist's check, The Arc needs their social security number. This is a regulation needed to check for any Medicaid fraud. If your artwork is chosen, we will reach out after the event for this information.
- The selected artist agrees to be profiled in the event program and other public relations material as deemed necessary by the agency.
- All artists must pick up their unselected artwork by Friday, 11/30/24 from 7215 York Rd, Baltimore, MD 21212, or it will become the property of The Arc.

While reasonable precautions are taken to ensure the security of works ondisplay, artwork is displayed at the owner's risk. By submitting art for consideration, the artist authorizes the release of some personal information for review by staff of The Arc and by attendees of the event. The agency reserves the right to edit the artist's biography for use in the event program. Your signature below serves as an authorization for disclosure under HIPAA requirements.
